

3 on 3 Tournament Rules

1. Two players are required to avoid a forfeit.
2. Teams are comprised of only 3 players.
3. Teams may only substitute a player if an injury occurs or a teammate is unable to continue to participate in the tournament. The team is responsible to decide who will be eligible to claim the prize if the team wins the tournament. Both teams and the event staff must agree on the substitute participant.
4. Teams may be comprised of male and female participants, but are limited to only 2 participants that are members of organized basketball teams or leagues (school teams, AAU teams, park and recreation teams, etc.)
5. Early round games will only last 8 minutes or until one team scores 13 points first. Must win by 2 points.
6. The clock will run continuously for the entire game.
7. Each score of the basket counts as one point.
8. If the 8 minute time expires before either team reaches 13 points, the team with the most points wins.
9. Quarterfinals, semifinals and the championship game will last 11 minutes or the first team to 15 points. Must win by 2 points.
 - a. If the 11 minute time expires, the team with the most points wins.
10. Possession to start a game will be determined by a coin toss.
11. No dunking or hanging on the rim.
12. On defensive rebounds or steals, the ball must to be taken anywhere beyond the 3 point line.
13. One referee will be assigned to each court to handle disputes that arise.
14. Teams will be responsible for calling their own fouls and violations.
15. Common fouls (non-shooting) result in the start of a new possession for the offense.
16. Shooting fouls with a missed basket shall result in retained possession for the shooting team.
17. Shooting fouls with a converted basket shall result in the basket counted. No penalty, play continues as if there were no foul with the defense taking the ball.
18. Hard, intentional shooting fouls will result in the start of a new possession by the offense, with a missed or converted basket, and the team fouled will get an additional point as a penalty.
19. At the end of regulation time, if there is a tie the game continues into sudden death.
 - a. Rules for sudden death:
 - i. Coin Toss to determine first possession
 - ii. Winner gets ball first.
 - iii. First to score wins the game.
20. The losing team is eliminated from the tournament (single-elimination).
